System upgrade changes in the HWE Shared Care Record


The Health Information Exchange (HIE) technology that creates our Shared Care Record will be upgraded at the end of July 2023. Many of the changes are behind the scenes improvements to known performance issues but users will notice some changes to the way information is displayed.

1. The Loading Partners button will be renamed to Partners finished loading.




Clicking this button will still show you whether information has loaded successfully from external connections, (partners that aren't connected directly to our HIE, such as the London Care Record).

2. The **Lab Results** section will be renamed to **Blood Sciences** and the way tests are grouped together has been simplified.



- 2. Test results **below and above** the usual range will be displayed in red.
- 3. Entries in **Blood Sciences** and **several other sections** now show the **time** they were recorded in addition to the date.



4. Detail within the **Problem List** section will show a new field called **Type**.

Click on a line entry to see this level of detail or change **Summary** to **Details** view in the drop down menu at the top of the section.


The **Type** field will show if an entry has been recorded as a **diagnosis** or a **problem**.







6. On rare occasions an alert may appear on the menu bar at the top of the page.
